There are 3 levels for skiing and snowboarding lessons **PLEASE REVIEW**

### SKI LEVELS

**NOVICE** – an intro to skiing designed for first- or second-time skiers. We stay on the Bunny Hill and if comfortable move to chairlift.

**GREEN** – ski improvement for skiers that can turn both ways and stop using a snowplow stance. We generally go straight to the top of the chair.

**BLUE** – skiers that can parallel ski and are ready for a new challenge.

### SNOWBOARD LEVELS

**NOVICE** – an intro to snowboarding designed for first- or second-time snowboarders. We stay in the beginner area.

**ORANGE** – rider improvement for snowboarders who are ready to start turning or still have trouble linking turns. We go straight to the top of the hill.

**BLACK** – confident riders who want to improve their skills.

## **Teacher & Chaperone Checklist**

### **Please have this information ready when you arrive**

- Number of students you brought
- **Signed Rental Form and Consent form**
- Number of students who have their own equipment / season pass
- Number of adults (supervisors) who need lifts / rentals / lesson

### **Bring An Emergency Vehicle**

We STRONGLY advise that each school arranges to bring an emergency (private) vehicle, specifically designated for the purpose of transporting students that may become injured to the hospital. Please have a vehicle and the designated driver available for this purpose if possible.

### **Please Provide Volunteers**

We ask that each school please provide volunteers to stand at the rental exit door to write equipment numbers on the students lift pass. This helps to avoid any mix up on skis and snowboards once outside. Please bring sharpie markers.

### **Teacher & Chaperone Lift Tickets**

- Each school will receive one complimentary lift ticket for every 10 students in attendance
- School rates apply for chaperones (must be 18 years of age or older) that are not covered in the complementary allowance
- Chaperones must pay the school not the ski hill and will be included in the total school payment
- All teachers and chaperone lift tickets will be issued only after the students have received their lift tickets. The teacher in charge will pick up these tickets for the Snow School Team member.
