PARENT INFORMATION

PLEASE NOTE THIS IS FOR YOUR INFORMATION

Dear Parents/Guardian

Thank you for allowing your child to come and enjoy a day at our facility. We would like to bring up a few points to make your child's visit as enjoyable as possible

1. Make sure your child (ren) are dressed appropriately for outdoor winter activities (ie. Warm clothes, mitts, toques, neck warmers, ski pants, long johns)
2. You should make sure your child has access to proper nourishment for the day
3. Beginner ski and snowboard lesson (Red & Yellow) take place starting at 10am, Intermediate and Advanced lessons will take place after the beginner lessons have been completed.
4. Please remind your child that they should ski/ride to THEIR ability ONLY!
5. The facility is open to public on your ski day and ALL ski runs INCLUDING terrain park and black diamond are open.
6. We request that ALL SCHOOL GROUP PARTICIPANTS are NOT ALLOWED in the terrain park. Upon special requests from Chaperones and Parents a terrain park lesson would be available.
7. We have at times had problems with theft. We therefore recommend that all valuables be left at home, or they should be secured in lockers in which we have limited amount available at the cost of one dollar per use. Another option may be to arrange with drivers to leave extra items on the bus or vehicle.
Please Note: We will not be responsible for missing items.
8. We need some information about your child to be able to properly fit their skis or snowboards. Specifically, we need to know your child's height, weight and shoe size. Please make sure your child brings this form with them on their ski day.

Please be aware that the following disclaimer must be read, and signed when completing the online form.

I, understand that the binding system cannot guarantee the users' safety. In downhill skiing, the binding system will not always release or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release. In snowboarding, and other sports utilizing equipment with non-release bindings, the binding system will ordinarily release during use, these bindings are not designed to release because of forces generated during ordinary operations.

I, understand that the sports of skiing, snowboarding and other sports (collectively "Recreational Snowsports") involve inherent and other risks of INJURY and DEATH. I voluntarily agree to expressly assume all risks of injury or death that may result from these Recreational Snowsports, or which relate to the use of this equipment.

I, understand that a helmet designed for Recreational Snowsports use will help reduce the risk of some types of injuries to the use at slower speeds. I recognize that serious injury or death can result from both low and high energy impacts, even when a helmet is worn.

I, understand that once my child is assigned a lesson, **they cannot change it or their equipment** (ie. changing from snowboarding to skiing)
